Dear Faith Friends:



From Pastor Tom

Dear Members of Faith Lutheran Church,

Grace and peace is yours from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ! I am writing to share some changes in our life together at Faith during this chaotic time of Coronavirus precaution. Following the recommendation of our governing authorities, there will be no in person worship services or other activities on the church premises until further notice. Nevertheless, there are ways we can continue to be the church together. God is faithful, and together we will weather this storm!

I'm reminded of Psalm 46 from which Martin Luther drew inspiration and wrote the great Reformation hymn, "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God." "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear...". We need not be afraid! Why? "The Lord of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our refuge." Jesus, Immanuel, is God with us, and we are called by the Spirit of God to be the Body of Christ on earth. Let me share some words of wisdom from our Southwestern Texas Synod Bishop, the Reverend Sue Briner:

"We are church together; expressing our solidarity with our neighbor, local communities, our nation and our world means reducing all possible risk of transmission of this virus which can be lethal for our most vulnerable citizens. To think 'this doesn't apply to me and my community' does not take seriously enough our responsibility as people of God."

"I want to be clear: this time of social distancing – or better said, physical distancing – does NOT mean we are suspending who we are called to be as church! Rather, we must become church in new ways. After all, we are a church that offers its best in times of adversity. This moment invites us to continue to live out who we are as Christ's Body for the life of the world and imagine new ways to be church. If our times of worship have always been about equipping the saints for their ministry, how do we now unleash that potential?"

The FLC Council and staff have met and will continue to pray about how to unleash our potential here at Faith Lutheran Church. Here are some things we can and will do right now:

- Beginning March 29, our Sunday morning worship will be live steamed on Facebook at the usual time, 10:00 a.m. Go to www.faithlutheranaustin.org and click on the blue Facebook icon located at the bottom right of the rose window. The length of the current disruption is unknown. If necessary, online services will continue the following weeks, including Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services at 7:00 p.m., during Holy Week.
- Announcements and updates will be made prior to worship, in the *Herald* newsletter, posted online, and via email blasts.
- Your regular tithes and offerings will insure that the work of the Church continues. The website has a Pay Pal link to enable online giving. If this is not an option for you, please remember to mail your offering to the church office.
- Service to homebound members and others who are already isolated will continue and in fact will increase as needed. Council members and I will be in phone contact and offer assistance when possible.
- Outreach ministries like the Bread for All Food Pantry will continue to need your support. In the absence of canned and dry good donations, please consider monetary support. You can mail a tax deductible check directly to the Bread for All Food Pantry at Abiding Love Lutheran Church, 7210 Brush County Road, Austin TX 78749-2374, or mail it to our church office, marked for the Food Pantry.

Stay tuned for possible additional ministry opportunities.

The Psalmist writes, "Be still, and know that I am God." Keeping the Sabbath first means to cease from work and the cares of daily life. May God bless our ministry together and enable us to use extended time at home as Sabbath time. God's peace be with you and yours!

LWR Personal Care Kits -- During Lent Faith Lutheran joined Lutheran World Relief in A SEASON OF HOPE to announce to the world the HOPE of Christ by collecting Personal Care Kit items for those in times of need around the world. The scheduled collection of items was as follows: March 1 - bars of soap (4 to 5 oz, any brand, in original wrapping; March 8 - bath towels (light-weight towels desired due to faster drying, maximum size 52" x 27" with dark colors recommended); March 15 - toothbrushes (adult size, in original wrapping); March 22 - combs (sturdy); March 29 - nail clippers (metal, attached file optional); and April 5 (Palm Sunday) - bars of soap. Now, due to current Coronavirus guidelines, the scheduled LWR In-Gathering at both Palm Valley Lutheran-Round Rock on April 14 and the LWR In-Gathering at TLC-Seguin on April 15 have been postponed until the fall of 2020. Any of the Personal Care Kit items can be brought any time; however, the items needed most to fill more kits are combs, nail clippers, and soap. The collection box for Personal Care Kits along with the list of Personal Care Kit items will remain in the narthex to accept your donations. The congregation's help, as always, is much appreciated in participating with this worthwhile project. Please note: According to an e-mail from Lutheran World Relief, the Personal Care Kits as usual will still include 4 and 5 oz bars of soap; however, as of March 1, no boxes of bulk soap will be accepted nor, due to environmental concerns, will any fleece blankets be accepted.

<u>LWR School Kits</u> -- A number of school kits have already been put together by women of the church and some items are in plentiful supply to complete more kits; however, some are currently in short supply: crayons (12 or 24 count), 1-1/2" erasers, and scissors (child, blunt). The support of the congregation in gathering more of these school kit supplies for the fall LWR In-Gathering will be most appreciated.

Quilt and Kit Blessing Service - CANCELED! -- Due to current Coronavirus guidelines, the blessing service scheduled for March 29 by Pastor Tom Kesselring for the LWR quilts and kits prepared by Faith Lutheran members was canceled. It will be re-scheduled at a later date before the LWR In-Gathering in the fall of 2020.
