Pastor Tom Kesselring, recently retired from Immanuel Lutheran Church in Pflugerville, **has agreed to serve as our transition pastor**. His first day in the office will be Wednesday, September 4, and his first Sunday to lead our worship will be **September 8**. Pastor Tom will work on a part-time basis, presiding over worship 3 Sundays per month and spending about 10 hours in the office weekly, depending on our pastoral needs. Various supply pastors will preside one Sunday per month.

Take Action in Support of Refugees and Migrants

Eagle Pass Frontera Ministries is providing support at one of our synod's local congregations, *Iglesia Luterana San Lucas* in Eagle Pass. Daily they welcome up to 20 documented asylum seekers on their way to relatives in the USA. They hold a service of thanksgiving for safe arrival; provide dinner, breakfast, a bed to sleep in, a change of clothes, hygiene kit, towel, backpack, and reusable water bottle; and prior to departure they hold a service of Godspeed to send them on their way.

Catholic Charities of the Rio Grande Valley is the charitable branch of the Diocese of Brownsville. Located only two blocks from McAllen's main bus terminal, the new *Humanitarian Respite Center* at this site is positioned to welcome and serve the most vulnerable as they continue to pursue a new life in the United States.
